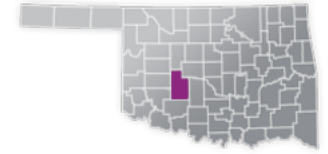

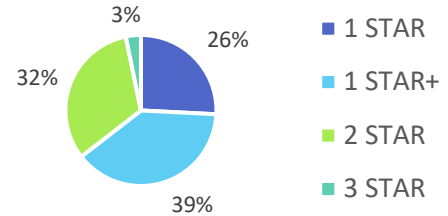

89.1% of 5 year olds are enrolled in a full or part day Kindergarten program.

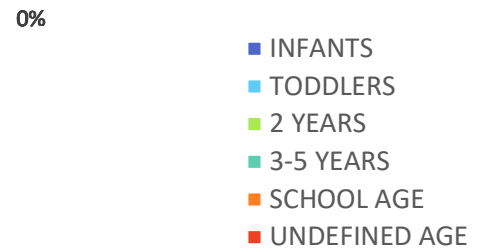

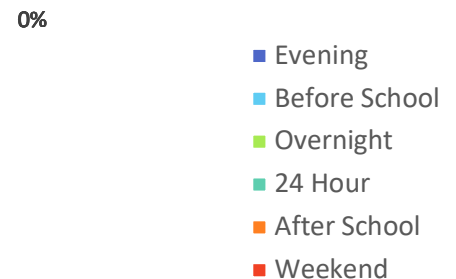
AMOUNT OF CARE SOUGHT
