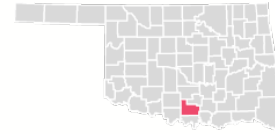

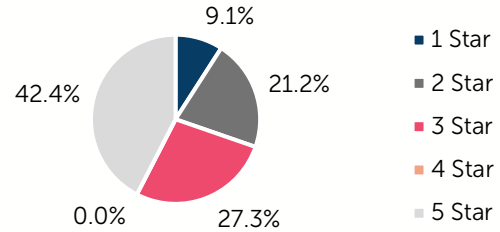

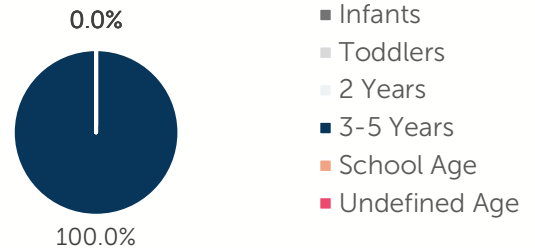


Amount Of Care Sought
