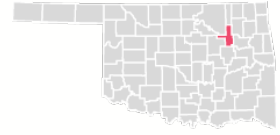

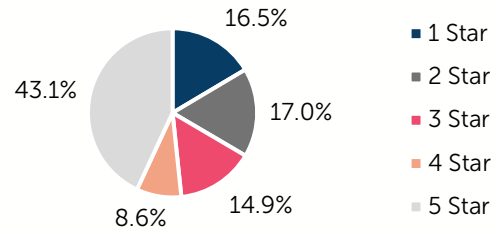

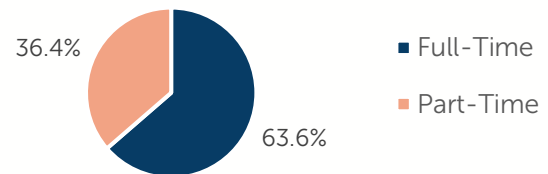

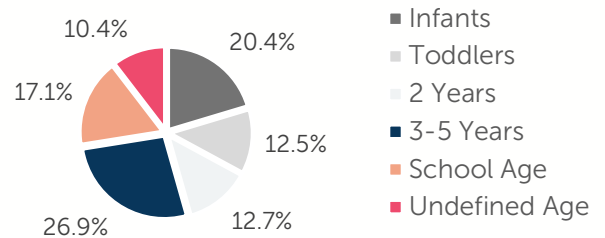

Ages For Whom Care Is Sought



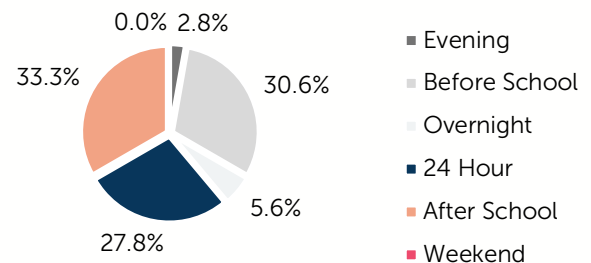
